



Infectious Disease Control Measures for COVID-19

LEVEL 1- No cases identified

- Implement a 48-hour exclusion policy for persons exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms (fever, coughing, shortness of breath) and/or flu-like symptoms (fever, chills, cough, sore throat, stuffy/runny nose, muscle/body aches, headaches, fatigue and/or vomiting or diarrhea. In coordination with the Champaign-Urbana Public Health District, the Nursery will assess the risk and determine if additional days are required.
- Children with family members in their home exhibiting symptoms will not be admitted. Parents will be screened during the initial call.
- Anyone entering the building is instructed to wash their hands upon arrival for 30 seconds with water and soap.
- All children will have their temperature taken during intake. Children exhibiting a fever of 99.5 or two or more symptoms of a contagious illness will not be admitted.
- Reduce to Master Volunteers in the building only, and schedule ratio accordingly.
- Sanitize intake spaces between use.
- Instruct children, staff or volunteers experiencing symptoms to contact their health provider for further recommendations. Proof of contact may be required.
- Ensure cleaning and sanitation of toys, materials, surfaces, phones, keyboards, etc. between first, second and third shifts.
- Review and follow diapering/toileting procedures.
- Sanitize the kitchen between meals and snacks.
- Drop off donations by appointment only.

LEVEL 2- A diagnosed case has been found in the community

- Level 1 measures will continue.
- Complete temperature checks at arrival for children, staff and volunteers.
- Discontinue tours and discontinue non-staff from entering buildings.
- Discontinue volunteers who are prone to becoming very ill from COVID-19 (elderly, those with underlying medical conditions, etc.).
- Discontinue home visits and appointments outside of the Nursery.

LEVEL 3- A diagnosed case has been found at the Nursery

- Level 1 and 2 measures will continue.
- Discontinue volunteers from entering the building.
- Work with C-U Public Health District on determining closure of the Nursery as needed.
